The ideal way to achieve all of this and keep up our gold standards is to ask for our members input and engagement.

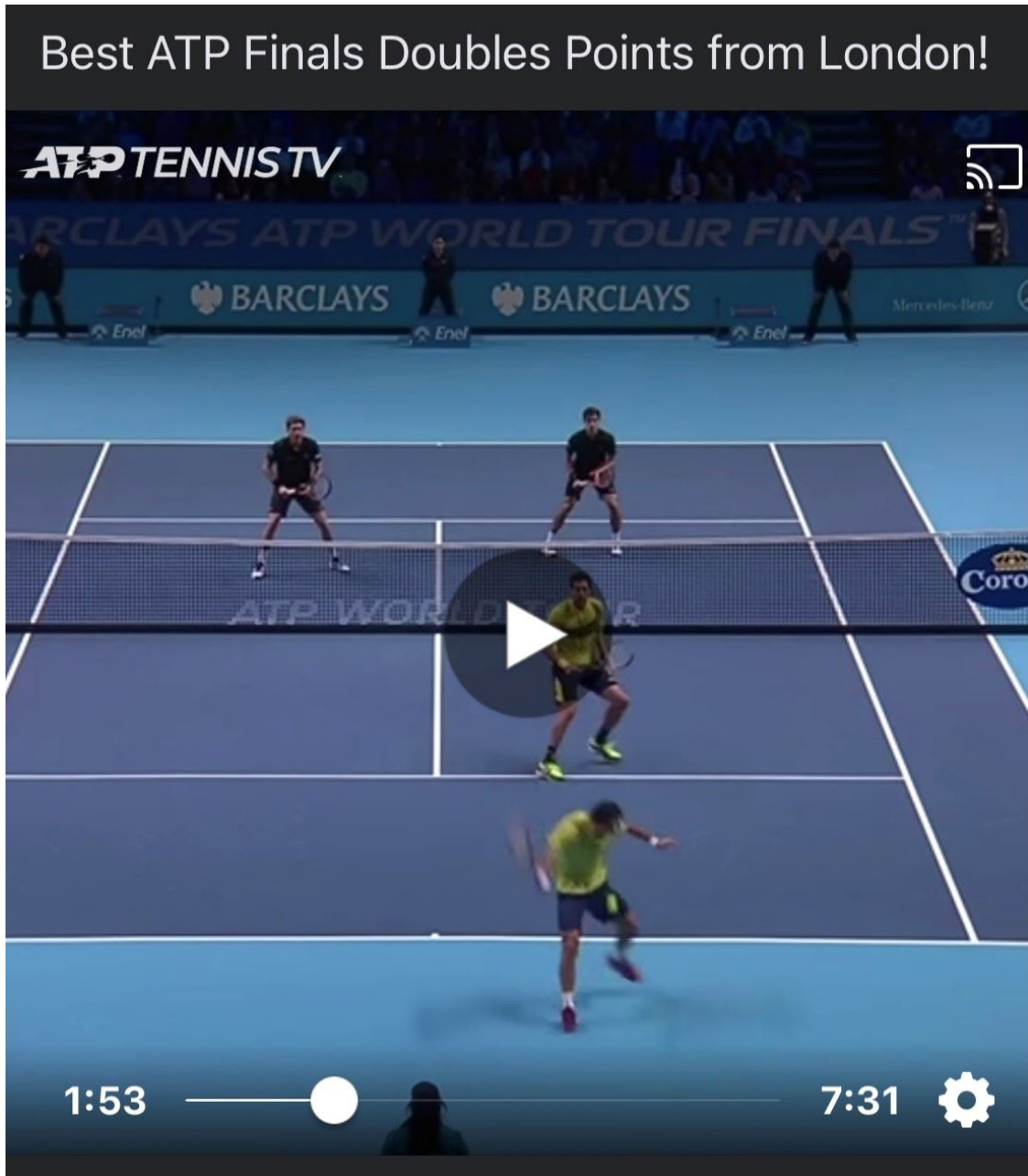
